Tiny Topper Knitting Pattern

Hat Size: 0-3 months

Finished Measurement: 12-1/2"

Yarn: Spud & Chloe Sweater or other worsted weight, 55 yards

Needles: Size #8 straight needle

Gauge: 4-1/2" = 1 inch

Loosely cast on 56 stitches. Knit 5 rows. Then change to stockinette stitch (k1 row, p1 row) until entire hat measures 4". End having just purled a row. Decrease as follows:

Row 1: K5, K2 tog, repeat to end of row, knit any remaining stitches.

Row 2, 4, 6, 8 & 10: Purl

Row 3: K4, K2 tog, repeat across row, knit any remaining stitches.

Row 5: K3, K2 tog, repeat across row, knit any remaining stitches.

Row 7: K2, K2 tog, repeat across row, knit any remaining stitches.

Row 9: K1, K2 tog, repeat across row, knit any remaining stitches.

Row 11: K2 tog, repeat across row, knit any remaining stitches.

Row 12: P2 tog, repeat across row, knit any remaining stitches.

Then K1 row, P1 row for 4 rows for knob on top of hat. Bind off all stitches. Sew seams & weave in ends.
